

NECESSARY INFORMATIONS FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A CANVAS

1) Photo

Photo of very good quality & a precise description of the desired order

Format, colors, delays ... etc

to send by email to raphael.dubesset@gmail.com

2) Quotation or Budget

- If you have a precise budget, it will be easier to explain what you can get for that price. (recommended)

- If you wish to have a quote, specify it in your email with the sending of the photo, add the desired format and other specific informations.

3) Down payment

- Once a sum has been agreed upon, a down payment is requested "before" the work is started, this is to buy the necessary equipment and also acts as a guarantee (no refund after payment of the 1st installment)

1) About 50% for a total of up to 1'000.- chf

2) About 35% for a total over 1,000.- chf

4) Price of a work

Prices may vary depending on the complexity of the subject

«Framing» is essential, it can change the price of a work drastically

A painting will be more expensive if the number of details is very large. For example, if the subject wears jewels, serrated clothes, complex hairstyle, crossed hands, several characters, positions or other complicated details. Also, the larger the format, the easier it will be to go into detail.

A character on abstract background will obviously take less time to achieve, so cheaper than if there is architecture behind him or a huge decor, that's why the framing is very important.

5) Corrections

During the creation of your work, a "photo" of the promotion is sent to you when the work is considered to be able to please the client by the artist,

If there are corrections to make, "2 to 3 times is the maximum", beyond that, a supplement will be asked on the remaining balance.

Additional complicated requests & changes, announced "after" the start may be refused, or accepted in exchange of a new amount
